RGC Police Department present Business Security Tips

Rio Grande City, Texas (April 19, 2016) — The Rio Grande City EDC and Rio Grande City Main Street Program, in partnership with City of RGC Police Department, held a Lunch & Learn seminar at the Kelsey Bass Museum and Event Center. At this session, Lt. Jose Solis and Officer Anna Ramirez presented information on how to minimize risk and protect your business from theft. Some tips presented in the seminar included: use of surveillance cameras, use of lighting for optimum visibility and keeping a record of serial numbers on all equipment.

Lt. Solis announced a new Rio Grande City Police Department program called Keepin' Rio Safe. This program consists of a system of business building checks, not only in response to calls or alarms but also at anytime an officer is on patrol. The RGC Police Department is proactive in deterring crime and in helping protect businesses by providing a visible security presence to promote a safe environment for Rio Grande City.

"This program is designed to give business owners a piece of mind and in the near future, we will be expanding it to include residences," said Lt. Solis.
